Helping small, local charities & groups

The Rotary Club of Worcester has established a temporary a fund from which it can make a limited number of donations (up to £500) to local charities and groups that are serving the local community.

The application process is by e-mail – there is not an application form – guidance for the e-mail is provided.

To apply you need to meet the following conditions:

- You are a registered charity or group that is providing services to the community in Worcester or Worcestershire
- You are a small charity. The requirements for this are not fixed but typically you are not a national charity or a charity that has employed or contracted fund-raisers
- You are not benefiting from significant emergency support from public funds
- You can explain how the pandemic has impacted your operations and how the grant will be used.

Please note:

- Applications will be processed in the order that they are received.
- All applications will be acknowledged – if you do not receive an acknowledgement within 2 days, please contact us.
- We aim to provide a decision within 10 working days.
- The Rotary Club of Worcester will publicise the award of grants – amount and recipient

OUTLINE FOR APPLICATION E-MAIL

1. Name of charity or group – website details if applicable
2. Contact details: Name, position, e-mail, telephone number
3. Brief description of what it is you do and how you are funded.
4. Amount of grant requested – up to a maximum of £500, only one application per group.
5. Describe how the grant will be used.
6. Payment will be by cheque so we will need:
